Capital College Preparatory Academy Scholars Receive Two STEM Awards

The Springfield School District's Capital College Preparatory Academy has won the Northern Illinois University's "Best In Show" STEM Fest (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) statewide video competition.

The "Explain it!" video competition is a statewide program sponsored by the NIU STEM Outreach Program. Elementary, Middle and Secondary schools entered the competition. CCPA's Middle School entry features sixth and seventh grade scholars. The video demonstrated two of Newton's laws of physics and explained the laws in an entertaining way.

In addition to winning "Best In Show," the CCPA team won the Middle School category as well.
